

How long will you hide your face from me?


2 How long must I wrestle with my thoughts

O give **thanks** unto the LORD, for he is good:


For his mercy endureth for ever. (Ps 107:1, KJV)



PSALM I WISDOM PSALM




For the **wisdom** of this world is **foolishness** in God's sight. (I Cor 3:19a, NIV)



PSALM I THE BOOK(S) OF PSALMS



- Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Amen and Amen.
 (Ps 41:13, NIV)
- Praise be to his glorious name forever; may the whole earth be filled with his glory. Amen and Amen. (Ps 72:19, NIV)
- Praise be to the LORD forever! Amen and Amen. (Ps 89:52, NIV)
- Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Let all the people say, "Amen!" Praise the LORD. (Ps 106:48, NIV)
- Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD. (Ps 150:6, NIV)

praise him in his mighty heavens. (Ps 150:1, NIV)




PSALM I:I PARALLEL PROGRESSION



Blissful is the one who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked,

or stand in the way of sinners,

or dwell in the assembly of mockers (Ps 1:1,AT)



PSALM I:I WALKING THE WRONG WAY



- They claim to know God, but by their actions they deny him. (Tit I:I6a, NIV)
- Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did. (1 Jn 2:6, NIV)
- Whoever says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. (I Jn 2:4, NIV)



PSALM I:I MOCKERS



7 Whoever corrects a **mocker** invites insults;

whoever rebukes the wicked incurs abuse.

8 Do not rebuke **mockers** or they will hate you;

rebuke the wise and they will love you. (Pr 9:7-8, NIV)

"Do not **give dogs what is sacred**; do not **throw your pearls to pigs**. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces. (Mt 7:6, NIV)

34 He mocks proud mockers

but shows favor to the humble and oppressed. (Pr 3:34, NIV)



PSALM I:I AMERICAN SELF-FULFILLMENT



- "To be fulfilled in life, you should pursue the things you desire most" (86%).
- "The best way to find yourself is by looking within yourself" (91%).



PSALM I:I TRUE BLISS



Whoever gives heed to instruction prospers,

and **blessed** is the one who trusts in the LORD. (Pr 16:20, NIV)

Blessed are those whose ways are blameless,


who walk according to the law of the LORD. (Ps 119:1, NIV)



PSALM I:I THE UNPOPULAR, ULTIMATELY FULFILLING WAY



- "Woe to you when everyone speaks well of you, for that is how their ancestors treated the false prophets." (Lk 6:26, NIV)
- II "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. 12 Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you." (Mt 5:11-12, NIV)
- Remember what I told you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also. (Jn 15:20a, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 LAW, INSTRUCTIONS DIRECTIONS




but rather in the law of the LORD they delight;

She speaks with wisdom,


and faithful instruction [torah] is on her tongue. (Pr 31:26, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 MEDITATE ON THE LORD'S INSTRUCTIONS




- He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms." (Lk 24:44, NIV)
- Keep this Book of the Law [torah] always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. (Jos 1:8, NIV)
- "Remember the law [torah] of my servant Moses, the decrees and laws
 [torah] I gave him at Horeb for all Israel. (Mal 4:4, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 MEDITATE ON THE LORD'S INSTRUCTIONS



- Thy word have I hid in mine heart, That I might not sin against thee. (Ps II9:II, KJV)
- 97 Oh, how I love your law [torah]!
 - I meditate on it all day long.
- 98 Your commands are always with me
 - and make me wiser than my enemies.
- 99 I have more insight than all my teachers,
 - for I meditate on your statutes. (Ps 119:97-99, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 MEDITATE ON THE LORD'S INSTRUCTIONS



103 How sweet are your words to my taste,

sweeter than honey to my mouth!

104 I gain understanding from your precepts;

therefore I hate every wrong path.

105 Your word is a lamp for my feet,

a light on my path. (Ps 119:103-105, NIV)



PSALM I:3 GODLY PROSPERITY



And they are like a tree (trans)planted by streams of water; which gives fruit in its season; and whose leaf does not wither; whatever they do prospers (Ps 1:3,AT) so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose [אָלַח] for which I sent it. (Is 55:11, NIV)



PSALM 1:4 GONE WITH THE WIND



Not so the wicked;

but rather, they are like chaff that the wind blows away (Ps 1:4, AT).




PSALM I:5 CAN'T STAND IT



Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment;

nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous (Ps 1:5,AT).




PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS



For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous,

but the way of the wicked will perish. (Ps 1:6,AT)



PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS




5 This is what the LORD says: "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the LORD. 6 That person will be like a **bush in the wastelands**; they **will not see prosperity** when it comes. They will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives. 7 "But **blessed** is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him. 8 They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes: its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit." (Jer 17:5-8, NIV)



PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS



- For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish (ἀπόλλυμι | *apollymi*) but have eternal life. (Jn 3:16, NIV)
- But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. (Mt 7:26, NIV)
- 13 "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and **broad is the road** that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. 14 But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it. (Mt 7:13-14, NIV)



THE LORD LISTENS TO THOSE WHO LISTEN



- The LORD is far from the wicked,
 - but he hears the prayer of the righteous. (Pr 15:29, NIV)
- The LORD detests the sacrifice of the wicked,
 - but the **prayer** of the **upright pleases** him. (Pr 15:8, NIV)
- If anyone turns a **deaf ear** to my **instruction [torah]**,
 - even their prayers are detestable. (Pr 28:9, NIV)
