


CONTEXT





- I want you to know how hard I am contending for **you** and for those at **Laodicea**, and for all who **have not met me personally**. (Col 2:1, NIV)
- You learned it from **Epaphras**, our dear fellow servant, who is a **faithful minister of Christ** on our behalf, (Col 1:7, NIV)
- 12 **Epaphras**, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured. 13 I vouch for him that he is working hard for you and for those at **Laodicea** and **Hierapolis**. (Col 4:12-13, NIV)
- After this letter has been read to you, see that it is also **read in the church of the Laodiceans** and that you in turn read the letter from Laodicea. (Col 4:16, NIV)






•And to the angel of the church in Laodicea write: Thus says the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: (Rev 3:14, AT)










Whoever is blessed in the land







12 "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write:




REVELATION 3:15-16 LUKEWARM









- And if you defile the land, it will **vomit** you out as it **vomited** out the nations that were before you. (Lev 18:28, NIV)




REVELATION 3:17 DIVINE DIAGNOSIS








•I know your afflictions and your **poverty**—yet you are **rich**! (Rev 2:9, NIV)




REVELATION 3:18 DIVINE PRESCRIPTION




