PSALM I:I PROGRESSIVE PARALLELISM



Blissful is the one who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked,

or stand in the way of sinners, or dwell in the assembly of mockers (Ps 1:1, AT)



PSALM 1:2 DELIGHTING IN/ MEDITATING ON GOD'S INSTRUCTIONS



but rather in the law [תוֹרָה | $tôr\hat{a}$] of the LORD [YHWH] they delight; and on His law [תוֹרָה | $tôr\hat{a}$] they meditate day and night. (Ps 1:2, AT)



PSALM 1:3 GODLY PROSPERITY



And they are like a tree (trans)planted by streams of water; which gives fruit in its season; and whose leaf does not wither; whatever they do prospers.

(Ps 1:3, AT)



PSALM 1:4 THE UNGODLY: GONE WITH THE WIND



Not so the wicked;

but rather, they are like chaff that the wind blows away.

(Ps 1:4, AT)




PSALM 1:4 THE UNGODLY: GONE WITH THE WIND



But your many enemies will become like fine dust, the ruthless hordes like blown **chaff**.

(Is 29:5ab, NIV)







His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire." (Mt 3:12, NIV)



PSALM 1:5 JUDGMENT



Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment; nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. (Ps 1:5, AT)





For the LORD [YHWH] watches over [פָּדְע | yāda ʿ] the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish [LXX: ἀπόλλυμι | apollymi].

(Ps 1:6, AT)





And Adam knew [37] yāda Teve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD [YHWH]. (Gen 4:1, KJV)







18 The path of the righteous is like the morning sun, shining ever brighter till the full light of day.

19 But the way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know what makes them stumble.

(Pr 4:18-19, NIV)





- 18 The blameless spend their days under the LORD's [YHWH's] care,
 - and their inheritance will endure forever.
- 19 In times of disaster they will not wither; in days of famine they will enjoy plenty.
- 20 But the wicked will perish:
 - Though the LORD's [YHWH's] enemies are like the flowers of the field, they will be consumed, they will go up in smoke.

(Ps 37:18-20, NIV)







For I envied the arrogant when I saw the **prosperity** of the wicked.

(Ps 73:3, NIV)





This is what the wicked are like—

always free of care, they go on amassing wealth.

(Ps 73:12, NIV)







13 Surely in vain I have kept my heart pure and have washed my hands in innocence.
14 All day long I have been afflicted, and every morning brings new punishments.

(Ps 73:13-14, NIV)





16 When I tried to understand all this,

it troubled me deeply

17 till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their final destiny.

(Ps 73:16-17, NIV)







Those who are far from you will perish; you destroy all who are unfaithful to you.

(Ps 73:27, NIV)





- 1 Do not fret because of those who are evil or be envious of those who do wrong;
 2 for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away.
- (Ps 37:1-2, NIV)





Be still before the LORD [YHWH] and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. (Ps 37:7, NIV)





10 A little while, and the wicked will be no more;

though you look for them, they will not be found.

11 But the meek will inherit the land and enjoy peace and prosperity.

(Ps 37:10-11, NIV)





Blessed are the meek because they will inherit the earth. (Mt 5:5, AT)





12 The wicked plot against the righteous and gnash their teeth at them;
13 but the Lord laughs at the wicked, for he knows their day is coming

(Ps 37:12-13, NIV)





30 The mouths of the righteous utter wisdom,

and their tongues speak what is just.

31 The law [אֹרְהֹה $tôr\hat{a}$] of their God is in their hearts; their feet do not slip.

(Ps 37:30-31, NIV)





- 5 Trust in the LORD [YHWH] with all your heart, and on your own insight do not lean.
- 6 In all your ways be conscious of [יַלַל | yāda ʿ] [lit. know] Him and He will straighten your paths.

(Pr 3:5-6, AT)





- 1 I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills,
 - From whence cometh my help.
- 2 My help *cometh* from the LORD [YHWH], Which made heaven and earth.
- (Ps 121:1-2, KJV)





- 5 This is what the LORD [YHWH] says:
 - "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the LORD [YHWH].
- 6 That person will be like a bush in the wastelands; they will not see prosperity when it comes.
 - They will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives. (Jer 17:5-6, NIV)





- 7 "But **blessed** is the one who trusts in the LORD [YHWH], whose confidence is in him.
- 8 They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream.
 - It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green.
 - It has no worries in a year of drought
 - and never fails to bear fruit." (Jer 17:7-8, NIV)





For the LORD [YHWH] watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will **perish** [LXX: ἀπόλλυμι | *apollymi*]. (Ps 1:6, AT)





For, in this way, God loved the world: that He gave the one-of-a-kind Son, so that everyone who [continually] believes in Him shall not perish [ἀπόλλυμι | apollymi] but have eternal life. (Jn 3:16, AT)







Therefore, everyone who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the (bed)rock. (Mt 7:24, AT)





Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!' (Mt 7:23, NIV)





13 Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many are those who enter through it. 14 For narrow is the gate and hard is the road that leads to life, and few are those who find it. (Mt 7:13-14, AT)





15 The eyes of the LORD [YHWH] are on the righteous,

and his ears are attentive to their cry;

16 but the face of the LORD [YHWH] is against those who do evil, to blot out their name from the earth.

(Ps 34:15-16, NIV)








The LORD [YHWH] watches over all who love him, but all the wicked he will destroy.

The LORD [YHWH] is far from the wicked, but he hears the prayer of the righteous. (Pr 15:29, NIV)




PSALM 1:6 THE LORD LISTENS TO THOSE WHO LISTEN
