[The] beginning of the Gospel [(Good News)] of Jesus Christ [(Messiah)], Son of God – (Mk 1:1, AT)



## CONTEXT: REPENT AND BELIEVE THE GOSPEL!



14 Now after John was handed over [to be arrested], Jesus went into Galilee proclaiming the Gospel of God and saying: "The [appointed] time has been fulfilled and the Kingdom of God has come near. **Repent** and **believe** in the Gospel!" (Mk 1:14-15, AT)



### MARK 1:16 SEETHEM ON THE SEA OF GALILEE



While passing by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew, the brother of Simon, casting (a) net(s) into the sea – for they were fishermen. (Mk 1:16, AT)







1 And it came to pass: While the crowd pressed around Him to listen to the word of God, Jesus was standing by Lake Gennesaret. 2 And He saw two boats standing by the lake. The fishermen who had left them were washing the nets. (Lk 5:1-2, AT)



MARK I:16 POOR FISHERMEN?



Then, having gotten into one of the boats, which belonged to Simon, He asked him to put out a little from land. Then, having sat down, He began teaching the crowds from the boat. (Lk 5:3, AT)




### MARK 1:16 POOR FISHERMEN?



7 And then they signaled their (business) partners in the other boat so they would come to help them. And they came and filled both boats so that they began to sink. 8 Then, having seen this, Simon Peter fell down at the knees of Jesus saying, "Go away from me, for I am a sinful man, Lord!" 9 For amazement seized him and all those with him because of the catch of the fish that they netted. 10 And likewise for James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were Simon's companions. (Lk 5:7-10a, AT)







And Jesus said to them, "Come, [follow] after Me! And I will make you to be fishers of people." (Mk 1:17, AT)



### MARK 1:17 FISHERS OF PEOPLE



- 14 You have made people like the **fish in the sea**, like the sea creatures that have no ruler.
- 15 The wicked foe pulls all of them up with hooks, he catches them in his net, he gathers them up in his dragnet;

and so he rejoices and is glad.

(Hab 1:14-15, NIV)



### MARK I:17 FISHERS OF PEOPLE



3 Speak to him and say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD [YHWH] says:

"'I am against you, Pharaoh king of Egypt,

you great monster lying among your streams.

You say, "The Nile belongs to me;

I made it for myself."

(Eze 29:3, NIV)



#### MARK 1:17 FISHERS OF PEOPLE



- 4 But I will put **hooks in your jaws** and make the **fish** of your streams stick to your scales.
  - I will pull you out from among your streams, with all the **fish** sticking to your scales.
- 5 I will leave you in the desert, you and all the **fish** of your streams.
  - You will fall on the open field and not be gathered or picked up.

I will give you as food to the beasts of the earth and the birds of the sky. (Eze 29:4-5, NIV)







3 and say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD [YHWH] says: I am against you, Gog, chief prince of Meshek and Tubal. 4 I will turn you around, put hooks in your jaws and bring you out with your whole army—your horses, your horsemen fully armed, and a great horde with large and small shields, all of them brandishing their swords. 1 "Son of man, prophesy against Gog and say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD [YHWH] says: I am against you, Gog, chief prince of Meshek and Tubal. 2 I will turn you around and drag you along. I will bring you from the far north and send you against the mountains of Israel. 3 Then I will strike your bow from your left hand and make your arrows drop from your right hand. 4 On the mountains of Israel you will fall, you and all your troops and the nations with you. I will give you as food to all kinds of carrion birds and to the wild animals. (Eze 39:1-4, NIV)








The Sovereign LORD [YHWH] has sworn by his holiness: "The time will surely come

# They went out and preached that people should repent.

(Mk 6:12, NIV)



MARK 1:18 DROP EVERYTHING



Straight away, having left the

nets, they followed Him.

(Mk 1:18, AT)



### MARK 1:18 DROP EVERYTHING



And while He was passing by, He saw Levi [son] of Alphaeus sitting at the tax booth. And He says to him, "Follow me". And he got up and followed Him. (Mk 2:14, AT)







Going a little further, He saw James the [son] of Zebedee and his brother John, who were in the boat getting the nets in order. (Mk 1:19, AT)



### MARK 1:19 MORE FISHY BUSINESS



18 As Jesus was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed begged to go with him. 19 Jesus did not let him, but said, "Go home to your own people and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you." 20 So the man went away and began to tell in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him. And all the people were amazed. (Mk 5:18-20, NIV)



MARK 1:20 JESUS CALLING



Straight away, He called them. And leaving their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired workers, they went away after Him. (Mk 1:20, AT)





28 Then Peter spoke up, "We have left everything to follow you!" 29 "Truly I tell you," Jesus replied, "no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel 30 will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age: homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields along with persecutions—and in the age to come eternal life. (Mk 10:28-30, NIV)





- 59 He said to another man, "Follow me."
- But he replied, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father."
- 60 Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God."

(Lk 9:59-60, NIV)






61 Still another said, "I will follow you, Lord; but first let me go back and say goodbye to my family." 62 Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God." (Lk 9:61-62, NIV)





19 So Elijah went from there and found Elisha son of Shaphat. He was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen, and he himself was driving the twelfth pair. Elijah went up to him and threw his cloak around him. 20 Elisha then left his oxen and ran after Elijah. "Let me kiss my father and mother goodbye," he said, "and then I will come with you." "Go back," Elijah replied. "What have I done to you?" 21 So Elisha left him and went back. He took his yoke of oxen and slaughtered them. He burned the plowing equipment to cook the meat and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he set out to follow Elijah and became his servant. (1 Ki 19:19-21, NIV)


