LUKE 17:11 ON THE WAY TO JERUSALEM



Then, it came to pass: [Jesus] was on the way to Jerusalem and He was passing between Galilee and Samaria. (Lk 17:11, AT)



LUKE 17:11 ON THE WAY TO JERUSALEM



As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus **resolutely set out for Jerusalem**. (Lk 9:51, NIV)

# Then, as He [was] going into a village, ten lepers, who stood at a distance, met Him. (Lk 17:12, AT)



### LUKE 17:12 LEPROSY? DIVINE PUNISHMENT



8 With him I speak face to face, clearly and not in riddles; he sees the form of the LORD [YHWH]. Why then were you not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?" 9 The anger of the LORD [YHWH] burned against them, and he left them. 10 When the cloud lifted from above the tent, Miriam's skin was leprous—it became as white as snow. Aaron turned toward her and saw that she had a **defiling skin disease**, 11 and he said to Moses, "Please, my lord, I ask you not to hold against us the sin we have so foolishly committed. (Num 12:8-11, NIV)



LUKE 17:12 SOCIAL DISTANCING: THE LIFE OF LEPERS



1 The LORD [YHWH] said to Moses, 2 "Command the Israelites to send away from the camp anyone who has a defiling skin disease or a discharge of any kind, or who is ceremonially unclean because of a dead body. 3 Send away male and female alike; send them **outside the camp** so they will not defile their camp, where I dwell among them. (Num 5:1-3, NIV)



LUKE 17:12 SOCIAL DISTANCING: THE LIFE OF LEPERS



45 "Anyone with such a defiling disease must wear torn clothes, let their hair be unkempt, cover the lower part of their face and cry out, 'Unclean! Unclean!' 46 As long as they have the disease they remain unclean. They must live alone; they must live outside the camp. (Lev 13:45-46, NIV)

## "Whoever touches a human

## corpse will be unclean for seven

days. (Num 19:11, NIV)

# And they raised their voice, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" (Lk 17:13, AT)



#### LUKE 17:13 SUBMISSION PRECEDES SUPPLICATION



## "Father, **if you are willing**, take this cup from me; yet **not my will**, **but yours** be done." (Lk 22:42, NIV)



LUKE 17:14 WALK BY FAITH



And, when He saw [them], He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And it came to pass: as they were going, they were cleansed. (Lk 17:14, AT)



LUKE 17:14 WALK BY FAITH



13 Jesus reached out his hand and **touched** the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" And immediately the leprosy left him. 14 Then Jesus ordered him, "Don't tell anyone, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them." (Lk 5:13-14, NIV)



LUKE 17:15 TO GOD BE THE GLORY!



Then, one of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back – glorifying God with a loud voice. (Lk 17:15, AT)



LUKE 17:16 APPRECIATIVE OUTSIDER



And he fell facedown at the feet of Jesus, thanking Him. And he was a Samaritan. (Lk 17:16, AT)



LUKE 17:16 FALL ON YOUR KNEES



While Jesus was in one of the towns, a man came along who was covered with leprosy. When he saw Jesus, he fell with his face to the ground and begged him, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." (Lk 5:12, NIV)



LUKE 17:16 FALL ON YOUR KNEES



41 Then a man named Jairus, a synagogue leader, came and **fell at Jesus' feet**, **pleading** with him to come to his house 42 because his **only daughter**, a girl of about twelve, **was dying**.

(Lk 8:41-42a, NIV)



LUKE 17:17-18 RHETORICAL REBUKE



17 Then Jesus replied and said, "Were not ten cleansed? Then, *where* are the [other] nine? 18 None were found coming back to give glory to God except this foreigner?" (Lk 17:17-18, AT)



LUKE 17:19 SAVING FAITH



# And He said to him, "Arise! Go! Your faith has saved [σφζω | *sōzō*] you." (Lk 17:19, AT)



LUKE 17:19 SAVING FAITH



# Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has **healed** [σφίζω | *sōzō*] you. Go in peace." (Lk 8:48, NIV)



LUKE 17:19 HEALINGS: SIGNS OF SALVATION



So he replied to the messengers, "Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor. (Lk 7:22, NIV)



LUKE 17:19 SAVING FAITH



36 When one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, he went to the Pharisee's house and reclined at the table. 37 A woman in that town who lived a **sinful life** learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, so she came there with an **alabaster jar of perfume**. 38 As she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears. Then she wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them. (Lk 7:36-38, NIV)



LUKE 17:19 SAVING FAITH



48 Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."49 The other guests began to say among themselves,"Who is this who even forgives sins?"






She said to her mistress, "If only my master would see the prophet who is in Samaria! He would cure him of his leprosy." (2 Ki 5:3, NIV)















