Then Jesus said to the Jews who had believed Him, "If you remain in my word, truly you are my disciples. (Jn 8:31, AT)





Even as he spoke, many **believed** in him.

(Jn 8:30, NIV)





25 When they found him on the other side of the lake, they asked him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" 26 Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, you are looking for me, not because you saw the signs I performed but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. (Jn 6:25-26, NIV)





"From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him" (Jn 6:66, NIV)



JOHN 8:31 TRUE DISCIPLES OBEDIENTLY ADORE



"If you love me, keep my commands."

(Jn 14:15, NIV)



JOHN 8:31 TRUE DISCIPLES OBEDIENTLY ADORE



Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them." (Jn 14:21, NIV)



JOHN 8:3 I TRUE DISCIPLES OBEDIENTLY ADORE



23 Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. 24 Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me. (Jn 14:23-24, NIV)





21 Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. 22 But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation—23 if you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant. (Col 1:21-23, NIV)





1 Now I declare to you, brothers and sisters, the gospel I proclaimed to you, and which you accepted, and on which you have taken your stand, and by which you are saved, if you hold firm to the word I proclaimed to you – unless you believed in vain. (1 Cor 15:1-2, AT)





Everyone will hate you because of me, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved. (Mk 13:13, NIV)



JOHN 8:32 THE TRUTH WILL SET YOU FREE



Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (Jn 8:32, AT)



JOHN 8:32 THE TRUTH WILL SET YOU FREE



Jesus says to Him, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." (Jn 14:6, AT)



JOHN 8:33 DON'T NEED FREEING?



They answered Him, "We are the descendants of Abraham and none of us have ever been slaves. How can you say that "we will become free"? (Jn 8:33, AT)





2 "I will make you into a great nation,

- and I will bless you;I will make your name great,and you will be a blessing.
- 3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse;
 and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you." (Gen 12:2-3, NIV)





17 I will surely bless you and make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as the sand on the seashore. Your descendants will take possession of the cities of their enemies, 18 and through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me." (Gen 22:17-18, NIV)





5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy **nation**.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites." (Ex 19:5-6, NIV)





7 Understand, then, that those who have faith are children of Abraham. 8 Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you [Gen 12:3]." (Gal 3:7-8, NIV)





11 He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. 12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God. (Jn 1:10-13, NIV)





9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession [Ex 19:5-6], that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

(1 Pet 2:9-10, NIV)





4 John,

- To the seven churches in the province of Asia:
- Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come, and from the seven spirits before his throne, 5 and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth.
- To him who loves us and **has freed us from our sins by his blood**, 6 and has made us to be a **kingdom and priests** to serve his God and Father—to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen. (Rev 1:4-6, NIV)





Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly I say to you that anyone who [continually] sins is a slave of sin." (Jn 8:34, AT)





No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God's seed remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God. (1 Jn 3:9, NIV)





Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey—whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness? (Rom 6:16, NIV)





17 But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, 18 and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

(Rom 6:17-18, ESV)





20 When you were slaves to sin, you were free from the control of righteousness. 21 What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death! 22 But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. 23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom 6:20-23, NIV)





Now the **slave** does **not remain** in the household forever; the **Son remains** forever. (Jn 8:35, AT)





To those who sold doves he said, "Get these out of here! Stop turning my Father's house [οἶκος | oikos] into a market!" (Jn 2:16, NIV)





Jesus answered them, "Destroy **this temple**, and I will raise it again in three days." (Jn 2:19, NIV)





My Father's **house** [$oi\kappaia | oikia$] has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that **I am going there** to prepare a place for you? (Jn 14:2, NIV)



JOHN 8:35 SON VS. SLAVE



9 But Sarah saw that the son whom Hagar the Egyptian had borne to Abraham was mocking, 10 and she said to Abraham, "Get rid of that **slave woman and her son**, for that woman's son will **never share in the inheritance with my son Isaac**.

(Gen 21:9-10, NIV)



JOHN 8:36 TRUE FREEDOM, INDEED



So if the Son sets you free, you will be **free**, **indeed**.
