LUKE 1:26-33 BIBLE STUDY SLIDES

5 It came to pass, in the days of Herod, king of Judea, there was a priest named Zechariah from the priestly division of Abijah. And with him was his wife – from the (female) descendants [lit. "daughters"] of Aaron – and her name was Elizabeth. 6 Now they were both righteous in the sight of God, walking in all the commands and requirements of the Lord blameless(ly). 7 And they had no child, because Elizabeth was unable to have children, and they were both advanced in age [lit. in their days]. (Lk 1:5-7, AT)





8 And it came to pass, while he was serving as a priest in the Presence of God when it was the turn of his division, 9 according to the custom of the priesthood, he was chosen by lot to enter into the sanctuary of the Lord to burn an incense offering. 10 And the whole assembly of the people was praying outside at the time of the incense offering. (Lk 1:8-10, AT)





11 Then an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing at the right of the altar of the incense offering. 12 And when Zechariah saw [the angel], he was shaken and fear fell upon him. 13 But the angel said to him, "Do not fear, Zechariah, for your petition has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son. And you shall call him the name John." (Lk 1:11-13, AT)





14 There will be joy and exultation for you. And many, on account of his birth, will be overjoyed. 15 For **he will be great** in the eyes of the Lord, he may never drink any wine or alcoholic beverage, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit while still in his mother's womb. (Lk 1:14-15, AT)





16 And he will turn many of the descendants [lit. sons] of Israel back to the Lord their God. 17 And he will go before Him, in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the parents to their children, and the disobedient to the understanding of the righteous, to prepare for the Lord a people made ready. (Lk 1:16-17, AT)





- 18 Zechariah asked the angel, "How can I be sure of this? I am an old man and my wife is well along in years."
- 19 The angel said to him, "I am Gabriel. I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to tell you this good news.
- 20 And now you will be silent and not able to speak until the day this happens, because you did not believe my words, which will come true at their appointed time." (Lk 1:18-20, NIV)





21 Meanwhile, the people were waiting for Zechariah and wondering why he stayed so long in the temple. 22 When he came out, he could not speak to them. They realized he had seen a vision in the temple, for he kept making signs to them but remained unable to speak. (Lk 1:21-22, NIV)





23 When his time of service was completed, he returned home. 24 After this his wife Elizabeth became pregnant and for five months remained in seclusion. 25 "The Lord has done this for me," she said. "In these days he has shown his favor and taken away my disgrace among the people." (Lk 1:23-25, NIV)





22 Then God remembered Rachel; he listened to her and enabled her to conceive. 23 She became pregnant and gave birth to a son and said, "God has taken away my disgrace." 24 She named him Joseph, and said, "May the LORD [YHWH] add to me another son." (Gen 30:22-24, NIV)



LUKE 1:26 GABRIEL IN GALILEE



Then, in the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee that was named Nazareth (Lk 1:26, AT)

20 While I was speaking and praying, confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel and making my request to the LORD [YHWH] my God for his holy hill—21 while I was still in prayer, Gabriel, the man I had seen in the earlier vision, came to me in swift flight about the time of the evening sacrifice. 22 He instructed me and said to me, "Daniel, I have now come to give you insight and understanding. (Dn 9:20-22, NIV)

45 Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

- 11 But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?"
- 12 And God said, "I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain." (Ex 3:10-12, NIV)

- 6 "Alas, Sovereign LORD [YHWH]," I said, "I do not know how to speak; I am too young."
- 7 But the LORD [YHWH] said to me, "Do not say, 'I am too young.' You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. 8 Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you," declares the LORD [YHWH]. (Jer 1:6-8, NIV)



But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD [YHWH].

(Gen 6:8, NIV)



LUKE 1:31 UNEXPECTEDLY EXPECTING



And, behold: you will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you shall call His name Jesus. (Lk 1:31, AT)



LUKE 1:31 JESUS, THE SAVIOR



For she will give birth to a son, and you shall call Him by the name Jesus – because He will save His people from their sins. (Mt 1:21, AT)



LUKE 1:31 PROPHESIED PREGNANCY



Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel. (Is 7:14, NIV)



LUKE 1:31 PROPHESIED PREGNANCY



"Behold: the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and they shall call Him by the name, Immanuel" (which is translated, "God With Us"). (Mt 1:23, AT)




LUKE 1:32 THE GREAT SON OF THE MOST HIGH



He will be great, and will be called Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give Him the throne of His forefather, David. (Lk 1:32, AT)







Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

(Ps 91:1, NIV)







21 When all the people were being baptized, Jesus was baptized too. And as he was praying, heaven was opened 22 and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

- 1 After the king was settled in his palace and the LORD [YHWH] had given him rest from all his enemies around him, 2 he said to **Nathan the prophet**, "Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God remains in a tent."
- 3 Nathan replied to the king, "Whatever you have in mind, go ahead and do it, for the LORD [YHWH] is with you."
- (2 Samuel 7:1-3, NIV)



LUKE 1:32 THE THRONE OF HIS FOREFATHER DAVID



4 But that night the word of the LORD [YHWH] came to Nathan, saying: 5 "Go and tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD [YHWH] says: Are you the one to build me a house to dwell in? 6 I have not dwelt in a house from the day I brought the Israelites up out of Egypt to this day. I have been moving from place to place with a tent as my dwelling. 7 Wherever I have moved with all the Israelites, did I ever say to any of their rulers whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, "Why have you not built me a house of cedar?" '(2 Sam 7:4-7, NIV)



LUKE 1:32 THE THRONE OF HIS FOREFATHER DAVID



8 "Now then, tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD [YHWH] Almighty says: I took you from the pasture, from tending the flock, and appointed you ruler over my people Israel. 9 I have been with you wherever you have gone, and I have cut off all your enemies from before you. Now I will make your name great, like the names of the greatest men on earth. (2 Sam 7:8-9, NIV)





10 And I will provide a place for my people Israel and will plant them so that they can have a home of their own and no longer be disturbed. Wicked people will not oppress them anymore, as they did at the beginning 11 and have done ever since the time I appointed leaders over my people Israel. I will also give you rest from all your enemies. (2 Sam 7:10-11a, NIV)





"The LORD [YHWH] declares to you that the LORD [YHWH] himself will establish a house for you: 12 When your days are over and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish his kingdom. 13 He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

(2 Sam 7:11b-13, NIV)





14 I will be his father, and he will be my son. When he does wrong, I will punish him with a rod wielded by men, with floggings inflicted by human hands. 15 But my love will never be taken away from him, as I took it away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. 16 Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me; your throne will be established forever.' " (2 Sam 7:14-16, NIV)





- 5 "The days are coming," declares the LORD [YHWH], "when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch,
 - a **King** who will **reign wisely** and do what is just and right in the land.
- 6 In his days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety.
 - This is the name by which he will be called:

The LORD [YHWH] Our Righteous Savior. (Jer 23:5-6, NIV)







22 I will save my flock, and they will no longer be plundered. I will judge between one sheep and another. 23 I will place over them one shepherd, my servant David, and he will tend them; he will tend them and be their shepherd. 24 I the LORD [YHWH] will be their God, and my servant David will be prince among them. I the LORD [YHWH] have spoken. (Eze 34:22-24, NIV)





24 " 'My servant David will be king over them, and they will all have one shepherd. They will follow my laws and be careful to keep my decrees. 25 They will live in the land I gave to my servant Jacob, the land where your ancestors lived. They and their children and their children's children will live there forever, and David my servant will be their prince forever. (Eze 37:24-25, NIV)





For to us a child is born,

to us a son is given,

and the government will be on his shoulders.

Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,

Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (Is 9:6, NIV)





Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end.

He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness

from that time on and forever.

The zeal of the LORD [YHWH] Almighty

will accomplish this. (Is 9:7, NIV)

13 "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. 14 He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed. (Dn 7:13-14, NIV)

- 60 Then the high priest stood up before them and asked Jesus, "Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?" 61 But Jesus remained silent and gave no answer.
- Again the high priest asked him, "Are you the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed One?"
- 62 "I am," said Jesus. "And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven." (Mk 14:60-62, NIV)







The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said:

"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever." (Rev 11:15, NIV)
