








# LOVE: A WATERED-DOWN WORD











15 Then she [Delilah] said to him, "How can you say, 'I love you,' when you won't confide in me? This is the third time you have made a fool of me and haven't told me the secret of your great strength." 16 With such nagging she prodded him day after day until he was sick to death of it. (Jdg 16:15-16, NIV)



# THE GREATEST COMMANDMENTS: LOVE



35 One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 36 "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" 37 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' [Dt 6:5] 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' [Lev 19:18] 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." (Mt 22:35-40, NIV)



## CONTEXT: VINE AND BRANCHES



1 I am the Vine – the True [Vine] – and my Father is the Vinedresser. 2 Every branch in Me that does not produce fruit He takes away. And every [branch] that does produce fruit, He prunes to clean so that it will produce more. 3 Already, you are clean on account of the word I have spoken to you. (Jn 15:1-3, AT)







4 Remain in Me and I [will] in you. Just as the branch is unable to produce fruit by itself if it does not **remain** in the vine, in the same way, neither [are] you if you do not remain in Me. 5 I am the Vine, you are the branches. The one who **remains** in Me and I in them, this person produces much fruit because without me you are unable to do anything. 6 If anyone does not remain in Me, they are thrown outside like a branch and are dried up. And [people] gather them, throw them into the fire, and they are burned up. (Jn 15:4-6, AT)




## CONTEXT: VINE AND BRANCHES



7 If you remain in Me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you desire, and it will be done for you. 8 In this, my Father is glorified: that you may bear much fruit and prove to be my disciples. (Jn 15:7-8, AT)



#### JOHN 15:9 LOVED PEOPLE LOVE PEOPLE



As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you. **Remain** in my love. (Jn 15:9, AT)







If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, as I have kept the commands of My Father and remain in His love (Jn 15:10, AT)



#### JOHN 15:10 DO AS I SAY, DO AS I DO



- "My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work." (Jn 4:34, NIV)
- For I have come down from heaven **not to do my will** but to do **the will of him who sent me**. (Jn 6:38, NIV)
- 30 I will not say much more to you, for the prince of this world [Satan] is coming. He has no hold over me, 31 but he comes so that the world may learn that I love the Father and do exactly what my Father has commanded me. Come now; let us leave."

  (Jn 14:30-31, NIV)



#### JOHN 15:10 DO AS I SAY, DO AS I DO



- Then Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you remain in my word, truly you are my disciples." (Jn 8:31, AT)
- "If you love me, keep my commands." (Jn 14:15, NIV)
- Whoever has my commands and **keeps them** is the one who **loves** me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them."

  (Jn 14:21, NIV)



JOHN 15:10 DO AS I SAY, DO AS I DO



23 Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. 24 Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me. (Jn 14:23-24, NIV)







- •It [love] does not rejoice on account of unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth.

  (1 Cor 13:6, AT)
- •Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. (Rom 12:9, NIV)



#### JOHN 15:10 HE FIRST LOVED US



- •But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Rom 5:8, NIV)
- •For, in this way, God **loved** the world: that He gave the one-of-a-kind Son, so that everyone who [continually] believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. (Jn 3:16, AT)



#### JOHN 15:10 FOR YOUR OWN GOOD



28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. 29 For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. (Rom 8:28-29, NIV)







I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be made full. (Jn 15:11, AT)








- The precepts of the LORD [YHWH] are right, giving joy to the heart.
- The commands of the LORD [YHWH] are radiant, giving light to the eyes. (Ps 19:8, NIV)







This is my command: that you should love one another as I have loved you. (Jn 15:12, AT)







13 No one has greater love than this: that one give up one's life for one's friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command you. (Jn 15:13-14, AT)







I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. (Jn 15:15, NIV)







The LORD [YHWH] would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent. (Ex 33:11, NIV)







22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. (Gal 5:22-23, NIV)
