Then, on the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, when they would sacrifice the Passover [lamb], His disciples asked Him, "Where do You want us to go and make preparations so that You can eat the Passover [meal]?" (Mk 14:12, AT)





22 Then say to Pharaoh, 'This is what the LORD [YHWH] says: Israel is my firstborn son, 23 and I told you, "Let my son go, so he may worship me." But you refused to let him go; so I will kill your firstborn son.'" (Ex 4:22-23, NIV)





7 Then they are to take some of the **blood** and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the lambs. 8 That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast. (Ex 12:7-8, NIV)





13 The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are, and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt. 14 "This is a day you are to commemorate; for the generations to come you shall celebrate it as a festival to the LORD [YHWH]—a lasting ordinance. 15 For seven days you are to eat bread made without yeast. (Ex 12:13-15a, NIV)





"Celebrate the Festival of Unleavened Bread, because it was on this very day that I brought your divisions out of Egypt. Celebrate this day as a lasting ordinance for the generations to come. (Ex 12:17, NIV)





14 "Three times a year you are to celebrate a festival to me. 15 "Celebrate the Festival of Unleavened Bread; for seven days eat bread made without yeast, as I commanded you. Do this at the appointed time in the month of Aviv, for in that month you came out of Egypt. "No one is to appear before me empty-handed. (Ex 23:14-15, NIV)

And He sends two of His disciples and says to them, "Go into the city and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him." (Mk 14:13, AT)



MARK 14:13 PREPARATIONS FOR CELEBRATION IN THE CITY



5 You must not sacrifice the Passover in any town the LORD [YHWH] your God gives you 6 except in the place he will choose as a dwelling for his Name. There you must sacrifice the Passover in the evening, when the sun goes down, on the anniversary of your departure from Egypt. 7 Roast it and eat it at the place the LORD [YHWH] your God will choose. Then in the morning return to your tents. 8 For six days eat unleavened bread and on the seventh day hold an assembly to the LORD [YHWH] your God and do no work. (Dt 16:5-8, NIV)



MARK 14:14-16 GETTING THINGS READY FOR THE REDEEMER



14 And wherever he enters, tell the master of the house, "The Teacher says, 'Where is My guest room where I may eat the Passover [meal] with My disciples?" 15 And he will show you a large upstairs room, furnished and ready. Make preparations for us there. 16 Then the disciples left and went into the city and found things just as He had told them. And they made preparations for the Passover. (Mk 14:14-16, AT)



MARK 14:17-18 BREAKING BREAD WITH THE BETRAYER



17 And when evening came, He arrives with the Twelve. 18 While they were reclining [at the table] and eating, Jesus said, "Amen [truly], I say to you that one of you will betray Me – one who eats with Me." (Mk 14:17-18, AT)



MARK 14:17-18 BREAKING BREAD WITH BROTHERS... AND BETRAYER



- 33 "Who are my mother and my brothers?" he asked.
- 34 Then he looked at those seated in a circle around him and said, "Here are my mother and my brothers!
- 35 Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother." (Mk 3:33-35, NIV)



MARK 14:17-18 BREAKING BREAD WITH BROTHERS... AND BETRAYER



Even my close friend,
someone I trusted,
one who shared my bread,
has turned against me.

(Ps 41:9, NIV; cf. Jn 13:18)







And they began to be sorrowful and to say to Him one by one, "Surely, not I?" (Mk 14:19, AT)



MARK 14:20 DOUBLE-CROSSING DISH-DIPPER



But He said to them, "It is one of the Twelve – one who dips with Me in the dish." (Mk 14:20, AT)




MARK 14:21 IT HAS BEEN WRITTEN, AND ONE WILL BE SMITTEN



For, the Son of Man goes just as it has been written about Him. But woe to that man through whom the Son of Man is betrayed. It would be better for him if that man had not been born. (Mk 14:21, AT)







And while they were eating, He took [a loaf of bread. After He gave a blessing, He broke it and gave it to them, and said, "Take it, this is My body." (Mk 14:22, AT)





23 Then, He took a cup, and after He gave thanks, He gave it to them, and they all drank from it. 24 And He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many." (Mk 14:23-24, AT)





3 When Moses went and told the people all the LORD [YHWH]'s words and laws, they responded with one voice, "Everything the LORD [YHWH] has said we will do." 4 Moses then wrote down everything the LORD [YHWH] had said. He got up early the next morning and built an altar at the foot of the mountain and set up twelve stone pillars representing the twelve tribes of Israel. (Ex 24:3-4, NIV)





5 Then he sent young Israelite men, and they offered burnt offerings and sacrificed young bulls as fellowship offerings to the LORD [YHWH]. 6 Moses took half of the **blood** and put it in bowls, and the other half he splashed against the altar. 7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it to the people. They responded, "We will do everything the LORD [YHWH] has said; we will obey." (Ex 24:5-7, NIV)





Moses then took the blood, sprinkled it on the people and said, "This is the blood of the covenant that the LORD [YHWH] has made with you in accordance with all these words." (Ex 24:8, NIV)





20 He said, "This is the blood of the covenant, which God has commanded you to keep." 21 In the same way, he sprinkled with the blood both the tabernacle and everything used in its ceremonies. 22 In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. (Heb 9:20-22, NIV)





This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. (Mt 26:28, NIV)





In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you. (Lk 22:20, NIV)





In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." (1 Cor 11:25, NIV)





- 31 "The days are coming," declares the LORD [YHWH], "when I will make a **new covenant** with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah.
- It will not be like the covenant
 I made with their ancestors
 when I took them by the hand
 to lead them out of Egypt,
 because they broke my covenant,
 though I was a husband to them,"

declares the LORD [YHWH]. (Jer 31:31-32, NIV)





- 33 "This is the **covenant** I will make with the people of Israel after that time," declares the LORD [YHWH].
 - "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts.
 - I will be their God, and they will be my people.
- No longer will they teach their neighbor, or say to one another, 'Know the LORD [YHWH],'
 - because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the LORD [YHWH].
 - "For I will forgive their wickedness
 - and will remember their sins no more." (Jer 31:33-34, NIV)

For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life – a ransom for [in place of] many. (Mk 10:45, AT)



MARK 14:23-24 THE BLOOD OF THE COVENANT POURED OUT FOR MANY



10 Yet it was the LORD [YHWH]'s will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the LORD [YHWH] makes his **life an offering for sin**, he will **see his offspring** and **prolong his days**, and the will of the LORD [YHWH] will prosper in his hand.

11 **After** he has suffered,
he will **see the light of life** and be satisfied;
by his knowledge my righteous servant will **justify many**,

and he will bear their iniquities. (Is 53:10-11, NIV)



MARK 14:23-24 THE BLOOD OF THE COVENANT POURED OUT FOR MANY



12 Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he **poured out his life unto death**, and was numbered with the transgressors.

For he bore the sin of many,

and made intercession for the transgressors. (Is 53:12, NIV)



MARK 14:25 NEW WINE TO BE CONSUMED IN THE KINGDOM



Amen, I say to you that I will never again drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the Kingdom of God. (Mk 14:25, AT)

On this mountain the LORD [YHWH] Almighty will prepare a **feast** of rich food for all peoples,

a banquet of aged wine—

the best of meats and the finest of wines. (Is 25:6, NIV)
