CONTEXT: VICTORY NOT VANITY!



12 Now if Christ is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? 13 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. 14 And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain. (1 Cor 15:12-14, ESV)



CONTEXT: BURIED BODIES OF BELIEVERS ARE LIKE BURIED SEEDS



35 But someone will ask, "How are the dead raised? With what kind of body will they come?" 36 How foolish! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. 37 When you sow, you do not plant the body that will be, but just a seed, perhaps of wheat or of something else. 38 But God gives it a body as he has determined, and to each kind of seed he gives its own body.

(1 Cor 15:35-38, NIV)

CONTEXT: JUST AS THERE ARE DIFFERENT BODIES IN CREATION WE WILL HAVE DIFFERENT BODIES IN NEW CREATION



39 Not all flesh is the same: People have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another and fish another. 40 There are also heavenly bodies and there are earthly bodies; but the splendor of the heavenly bodies is one kind, and the splendor of the earthly bodies is another. 41 The sun has one kind of splendor, the moon another and the stars another; and star differs from star in splendor.

(1 Cor 15:39-41, NIV)




CONTEXT: BURIED BODIES OF BELIEVERS ARE LIKE BURIED SEEDS



42 So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable; 43 it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; 44 it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. (1 Cor 15:42-44, NIV)



Then he appeared to more than 500 of the brothers and sisters at once, most of whom live to this day, though some have fallen asleep. (1 Cor 15:6, AT)



I CORINTHIANS 15:52 ...AT THE LAST (TRUMPET) CALL...



- in an instant, in a blink of an eye, at the last trumpet. For [the] trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. (1 Cor 15:52, AT)



I CORINTHIANS 15:52 ...AT THE LAST (TRUMPET) CALL...



30 "Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. 31 And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other. (Mt 24:30-31, NIV)



I CORINTHIANS 15:52 DEATH TO DEATH!



The last enemy to be

destroyed is death.

(1 Cor 15:26, NIV)





18 For, as I have often told you before and now tell you again even with tears, many live as enemies of the cross of Christ. 19 Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is set on earthly things. (Php 3:18-19, NIV)





20 But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will **transform our lowly bodies** so that **they will be like his glorious body**. (Php 3:20-21, NIV)





13 Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope. 14 For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. (1 Th 4:13-14, NIV)





15 According to the Lord's word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. (1 Th 4:15-16, NIV)
