1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord. For this is right. 2 "Honor your father and mother" – which is the first commandment with a promise -3 "so that it may go well for you and that you will live long in the land." (Eph 6:1-3, AT)





Listen, my son, to your **father's instruction** and do not forsake your **mother's teaching**. (Pr 1:8, NIV)





My son, keep your **father's command** and do not forsake your **mother's teaching**. (Pr 6:20, NIV)





Listen to your father, who gave you life, and do not despise your mother when she is old. (Pr 23:22, NIV)





The proverbs of Solomon:

A wise son brings joy to his father, but a **foolish son brings grief to his mother**. (Pr 10:1, NIV)





A foolish son **brings grief to his father** and **bitterness to the mother** who bore him. (Pr 17:25, NIV)





Whoever robs their father and drives out their mother is a child who brings shame and disgrace.(Pr 19:26, NIV)





A discerning son heeds instruction,

but a companion of gluttons **disgraces his father**. (Pr 28:7, NIV)



EPHESIANS 6:1-3 "FIRST" COMMANDMENT WITH A PROMISE?



... but showing unfailing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments. (Ex 20:6, AT)



EPHESIANS 6:1-3 LIVE LONG AND PROSPER



17 But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, 18 I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess. (Dt 30:17-18, NIV



EPHESIANS 6:1-3 LIVE LONG AND PROSPER



If someone **curses their father or mother**, their **lamp will be snuffed out** in pitch darkness. (Pr 20:20, NIV)

"The eye that mocks a father, that scorns an aged mother, will be pecked out by the ravens of the valley, will be eaten by the vultures. (Pr 30:17, NIV)



EPHESIANS 6:1-3 LIVE LONG AND PROSPER... IN NEW CREATION?



14 For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, 15 by setting aside in his flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, 16 and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. (Eph 2:14-16, NIV; cf. Eph 3:9, 4:13, 4:24)



And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up [$\dot{\epsilon}\kappa\tau\rho\dot{\epsilon}\phi\omega$ | *ektrephō*] in the training $[\pi\alpha_1\delta\epsilon_1\alpha \mid paideia]$ and **instruction** [vou $\theta \epsilon \sigma i \alpha$ | *nouthesia*] of the Lord. (Eph 6:4, AT)



4 Listen [שָׁמַע | shema], O Israel! The LORD [YHWH] is our God, the LORD [YHWH] alone. 5 Love the LORD [YHWH] your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. (Dt 6:4-5, AT)



These words that I am

commanding you today are to be upon your heart. (Dt 6:6, AT)



Repeat them to your children. And talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk on the road, when you lie down and when you get up. (Dt 6:7, AT)



- Whoever spares the rod hates their children,
 - but the one who loves their children is careful to discipline them.
- (Pr 13:24, NIV)



Discipline your children, for in that there is hope;do not be a willing party to their death.(Pr 19:18, NIV)



- 13 Do not withhold discipline from a child;
 if you punish them with the rod, they will not die.
 14 Punish them with the rod
 and save them from death.
- (Pr 23:13-14, NIV)




- The rod and reproof give wisdom,

EPHESIANS 6:4 FATHERS, RAISE CHILDREN TO BE RIGHTEOUS



29 After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed [$\dot{\epsilon}\kappa\tau\rho\dot{\epsilon}\phi\omega$ | *ektrephō*] and care for their body, just as Christ does the church— 30 for we are members of his body. (Eph 5:29-30, NIV)



16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training $[\pi\alpha_1\delta\epsilon_1\alpha]$ paideia] in righteousness, 17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Tim 3:16-17, NIV)



6 Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did. 7 Do not be idolaters, as some of them were; as it is written: "The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry." [Exodus 32, The Golden Calf Incident] 8 We should not commit sexual immorality, as some of them did—and in one day twenty-three thousand of them died [Num 25:1-9]. 9 We should not test Christ [see Ex 17:2; Ps 78:18; 95:9; 106:14], as some of them did—and were killed by snakes [Num 21:5-6]. 10 And do not grumble, as some of them did—and were killed by the destroying angel [Ex 12:23; 1 Ch 21:15]. (1 Cor 10:6-10, NIV)



These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings [νουθεσία | nouthesia] for us, on whom the culmination of the ages has come. (1 Cor 10:11, NIV)

Train up a child in the way he should go:And when he is old, he will not depart from it.(Pr 22:6, KJV)
