

Not that I am speaking out of neediness, for I have learned – whatever [circumstances] I am in – to be content. (Php 4:11, AT)






PHILIPPIANS 4:12 THE SECRET OF CONTENTMENT IN ANY AND ALL CIRCUMSTANCES...

PHILIPPIANS 4:13 I CAN DO ALL THIS (BE CONTENT) THROUGH CHRIST

All $[\pi \tilde{\alpha} \zeta \mid pas]$ [this] I am able to do through Him who strengthens me. (Php 4:13, AT)



Nevertheless, you have done well to share with [me] in my affliction. (Php 4:14, AT)

29 For it has been graciously granted to you, for the sake of Christ, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for Him, 30 having the same struggle of which you saw I had and now hear I [still] have. (Php 1:29-30, AT)



PHILIPPIANS 4:15 NO ONE ELSE HELPED BUT YOU



And also, you yourselves know, Philippians, that at the first [preaching] of the gospel, when I went out from Macedonia, not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving except you, alone. (Php 4:15, AT)

For even in Thessalonica, once

PHILIPPIANS 4:17 CHRISTIAN CREDIT



I do not seek the gift, but I seek

the profit that is increasing to

your account. (Php 4:17, AT)



PHILIPPIANS 4:18 I'M GOOD, GOOD SACRIFICE



But I have received in full and have an abundance. I have been fully supplied, having accepted from Epaphroditus the [gifts] from you – a pleasant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice pleasing to God. (Php 4:18, AT)



PHILIPPIANS 4:18 I'M GOOD, GOOD SACRIFICE



Then burn the entire ram on the altar. It is a burnt offering to the LORD [YHWH], a pleasing aroma, a food offering presented to the LORD [YHWH]. (Ex 29:18, NIV)





And my God will fully supply every need of yours, according to His riches in glory through Christ Jesus. (Php 4:19, AT)





Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. (Lk 6:38, NIV; cf. Dt 15:10; Pr 19:17; Pr 22:9, 28:8, 27





10 Give generously to them and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the LORD [YHWH] your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to. 11 There will always be poor people in the land. Therefore I command you to be openhanded toward your fellow Israelites who are poor and needy in your land. (Dt 15:10-11, NIV)
